The Georgia Movers Association establishes this Code of Ethics as a guide to the members of the Association in dealing with the laws of the land. Each member of the Association agrees to conduct business in keeping with the code.

WE AGREE:

- 1) To operate our business within the minimum operating standards established by the Association.

- 3) To maintain all equipment, at each facility, in keeping with proper commercial practices and safety standards, and to observe all laws and safety regulations established to ensure the safety of our workers and the property of our customers.
- 4) To fulfill commitments to our customers to the best of our ability.
- 5) To observe all applicable law or regulations of state, federal, and other governmental bodies and to conduct only such operations as we can perform with competence.
- 6) To participate only in fair and honest advertising of products and services.
- 7) To avoid untrue, or misleading statements concerning a competitor or their methods of operations.
- 8) To use honest and accurate methods and equipment for weights and measurements.
- 9) To respond promptly to complaints by customers and settle disputes in a fair and reasonable manner.

Dear GaMA Mover and Associate Members:

Thank you for the honor and privilege of serving your Association and the moving industry during this past year. Our 77th year will be remembered as the year GaMA stood up to many legislative and regulatory battles. As our members, you drive our mission as an organization to be an active participant in legislative and regulatory initiatives. Together, we built coalitions with state and local governments, and promoted business opportunities for our members and associate members. We are diligently working to enhance Georgia's business climate through:

- Monitor critical issues, such as worker's compensation, healthcare, wage garnishments, and other employment law
- Legislation to shift household goods movers back to GA DPS
- Promoting positive changes to the tariff and transportation rules for household goods movers
- Encouraging good tax policy

In today's cost conscious business environment, we are always exploring new avenues that would benefit all of our members. GaMA provides the necessary direct access and vital networking with members that allows you to support your business strategy. In addition, the strength of the Association supports the health and vitality of not just the moving industry, but businesses throughout Georgia and the U.S.

On June 18, 2013, the GaMA Board voted on three important issues regarding the Association:

- 1) GaMA has changed the fiscal year to July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.
- 2) The rate schedule for movers will be determined by several factors, i.e., new member, number of trucks in fleet, number of moves per year, etc.
- 3) Due to financial considerations, and in light of the fact, the Association has been so successful in achieving the fuel surcharge and travel time in the tariff, the Board believes this special assessment to current members is reasonable and necessary to keep the Association viable. Therefore, the Board voted on June 18, 2013 to begin the new dues structure effective July 1, 2013. Invoices will be sent in July to reflect the new rates.

Below is the new rate structure for our Georgia Movers Association members:

◆ New Member (1 st year – one time only special rate)	\$300.00
◆ Current Member (under 5 trucks and less than 300 moves per year)	\$395.00
◆ Current Member (5-10 trucks and 300-500 moves per year)	\$495.00
◆ Current Member (10+ trucks and 500+ moves per year)	\$595.00
◆ Associate Member (increase from \$200.00)	\$300.00

The strength of GaMA is now, and always has been, its mover membership. We are here to serve all of our members and to promote the moving industry. We hope that you will renew your membership to help us make the coming year even more successful. Not only do we need your financial support, we need your active participation in our committees. Working together, we will continue to make a positive difference for our members. I hope that you will take a moment to reflect on these recent accomplishments with the tariff and consider its value to your organization.

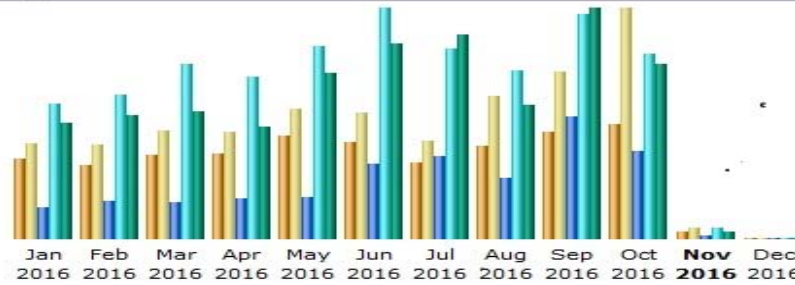

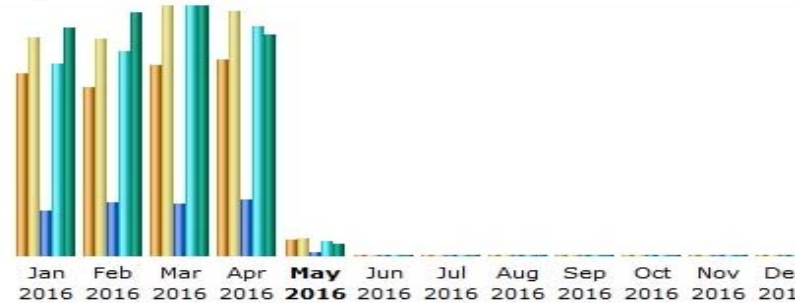
